LODGING:

The Tremont Plaza is situated about 11 miles from BWI Airport; a short shuttle ride to the hotel is available for \$13.00 each way. The all-suite hotel is adjoined to the Tremont Grand, the site of all of our meetings. The Grand was the former Grand Lodge of the Masonic Order and will captivate you with its ionic splendor. PARKING:

Valet parking with in and out privileges is available, \$25.00 per day OR parking next door, 15.00 per day, no in and out privileges.

MEALS:

Registration includes 3 Full Breakfasts, 3 Plated Dinners--Thursday and Friday at the Hotel, Saturday evening in Baltimore's famous Little Italy at the fabled Sabatinos (*travel will be by bus*)--, and a Sunday Box Lunch.

OTHER ACTIVITIES:

Friday bus trip to the Smithsonian, Washington, to view selected pieces from the in-storage collection of Ellouise Baker Larsen, author of *American Historical Views on Staffordshire China*. Following this visit, we will travel back to Baltimore to visit Fort McHenry, the birthplace of *The Star Spangled Banner*, celebrating its 150th anniversary this year. There will be a lecture on the defense of Baltimore during the War of 1812.

General admission for the Walters Museum is now free.
